



Pacific Harbour Golf Course and Country Club

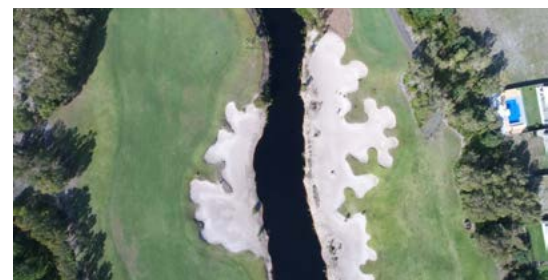
QM Properties sought to establish the Pacific Harbour Golf Course and Country Club, and integrated residential subdivision on Bribie Island. The 120-hectare, 600 lot project occupied a former pine plantation, but was bounded on two sides by Bribie Island National Park.

QM Properties saw a unique opportunity to harmonise the golf course landscaping with the wallum vegetation already occurring in the locality. Place Design Group landscape architects were appointed to coordinate a retention and recovery strategy for the wallum heath regenerating on the golf course site. We were appointed to assist with plant identification and selection, advise on construction management, and oversee translocation trials.

Outcome

In its debut year, the course was rated the 6th best public course by the authoritative Golf Australia magazine, and was later recognised as an Environmentally Sustainable Development “Champion Project” by the Urban Development Institute of Australia. This challenging and innovative project is a fine example of design from a multi-disciplinary approach, resulting in a sustainable and responsible outcome in a sensitive and demanding location.
